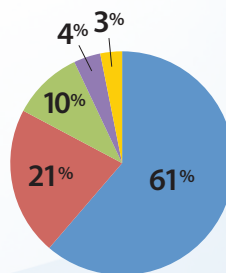

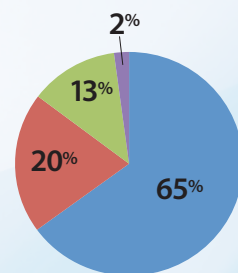

The SD FFA Foundation launched its **1st capital campaign** this fiscal year, and had astounding success. Thank you to all that made it possible!

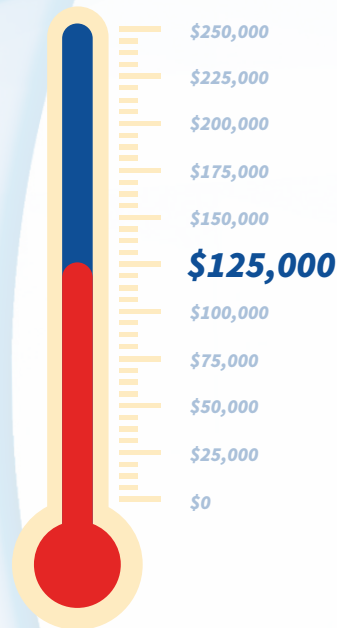
Progress as of June 2016 - **\$125,000**; with momentum!
